

Garden in a Box

INFORMATION PACKET



Thank you for your interest in the 2017 Garden-in-a-Box project! Neighbors with limited income, limited mobility, or who are new to gardening are eligible to apply. Currently, there are 148 boxes in circulation in Lansing's Eastside neighborhood, and there are 6 more boxes available this year.

From Allen Neighborhood Center, participants will receive the following, free of charge:

- One 2ft x 2ft raised garden bed filled with soil; installed by Youth Service Corps members.
- Seeds or transplants of desired plants (see space requirements); Youth Service Corps members will help with planting.
- Additional home gardening assistance, as requested, through our Yard Call program.

In exchange, our program requirements are:

- Participants attend the **Gardening 101** workshop on **Saturday, April 15, 12:30 pm - 2:00 pm**, at the Hunter Park GardenHouse. (This workshop acts as the orientation for the program. The workshop fee will be waived. If you cannot attend, participants must contact the Gardening Educator to re-schedule.)
- Participants complete and return a pre and post-season survey. Your feedback is really important and helps us to continue to offer programs like this for others.
- Participants complete a photo release form (photo release is optional).
- Participants devote regular time to caring for, watering, and weeding your garden; this will make sure you get the best harvest out of your garden!
- Participants help promote gardening to neighbors, family, and friends.

Planning Your Garden

We will work with each individual to choose plants that will maximize your space and gardening success. Some plants are better suited for planting during cooler months, such as salad greens and spinach; others, such as tomatoes, peppers and eggplants, need warmer weather to thrive. It's important to keep this in mind when planning your garden.

Youth Service Corps will bring the plants/seeds and soil to plant together with you. Depending on what you choose to grow, you can expect to spend a few hours each week tending to your garden.



About Youth Service Corps

Youth Service Corps, a job and life-skills training program for youth ages 11-17, focuses on food and nutrition awareness, healthy lifestyle choices, a sense of place, and civic responsibility. Through the Garden-in-a-Box project, Youth Service Corps members learn basic carpentry, horticulture, and community engagement skills, and Eastside neighbors gain access to small-scale gardening education. As a long-standing part of Allen Neighborhood Center's Youth Service Corps program, the Garden-in-a-Box project was developed by youth to help address issues of food security in the neighborhood.
