How can my child join the program?

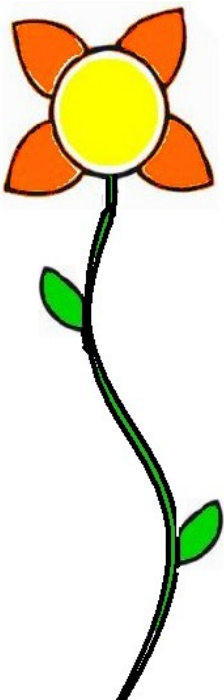
