Fee Structure

1. Prepaid Reserved Booth

Vendors who choose to prepay for the entire 27 week outdoor season will be charged a rate of **\$12.00** per market (\$324 for the season) and will have a spot automatically reserved for those dates. The full prepaid amount is due no later than one week prior to the first market.

2. Pay as You Go (PAYG) Reserved Booth

If a vendor wishes to reserve a space for specific dates, but would rather pay their fee on a weekly basis, each reserved booth/date designated will cost a rate of **\$16.00** per market.

- Once the Market Manager has accepted your application, a **Reservation Agreement** will be filled out to determine which payment option you prefer and to confirm dates. This document will be signed by yourself and the Market Manager and kept on file.

We require that products be clearly labeled with this information at each market. Vendors selling items they did not grow themselves must be familiar with the conditions under which they were produced.
