Provides help with weatherization, replacing or repairing furnaces and water heaters, new insulation and new windows (for eligible residents) Applicants must meet income guidelines and attend classes. Both homeowners and renters may qualify.

Provides help with repairing homes or replacing items such as a furnace in case of an emergency. Must own and occupy a single family home and meet income guidelines.

State Emergency Relief (SER) assists with home repairs to correct unsafe conditions and restore essential services. Eligible home repairs may include repair or replacement of a non-functioning furnace, hot water heaters or septic systems.
